

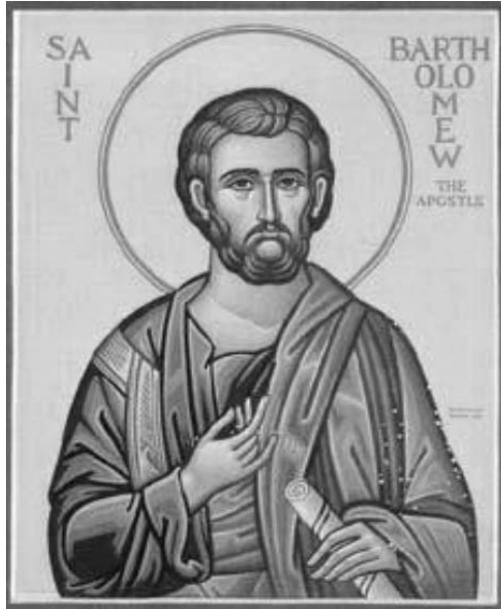

FAMILY CONNECTION

Jesus' parables in this week's Gospel are a reminder of the importance of continued learning, prayer and reflection, and humility in our discipleship. We shine God's light in the world when we are "lit from within" with God's grace, willing to examine our own conscience and recognize our own need for transformation through Jesus. As busy parents responsible for our children's physical, emotional, and spiritual growth, we may sometimes be challenged to find time and energy to care for ourselves and attend to our own spiritual growth. Yet doing so can improve our family relationships and help us guide our children in their faith. We can be reminded of the simple safety instruction we hear when flying: to put on our own "spiritual" oxygen mask before helping others.

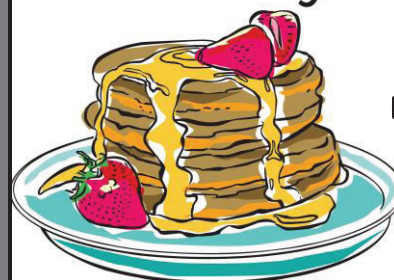
Gather as a family and spend some time discussing ideas about what it means to be a good disciple. What do we need to learn? How are we to act? How do we treat others? Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 6:39-45. Discuss what Jesus means when he asks, "Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?" Talk about how we might be tempted to focus on one another's shortcomings without noticing our own and how this might lead to conflict. Point out that part of being a good disciple is focusing on our own behavior. As a family, share ideas for

responding as a disciple when you are upset with another family member's words or actions. (For example, taking a cooling off break before talking to the person or praying for help to see if our actions contributed to the conflict and we need to apologize.) Pray that you will grow together in your discipleship and then pray the Lord's Prayer.

Hospital Chaplains

- Our Archdiocesan hospital priest chaplains provide sacramental care as well as pastoral care, spiritual guidance and prayers at the bedside.
- Despite restrictions in some hospitals, priest chaplains continue to have access to hospitals.
- Given the current restrictions, many hospitals are not yet allowing the priest chaplains to make non-urgent visits using the list of registered Catholic patients. If a patient desires to see a priest, please ask the patient or family member to speak to the patient's nurse to make a request.
- Gently remind parishioners' not to not wait for the last minute to request the attendance of a priest.
- Given the large turnover of staff in the hospitals, if a patient or family is incorrectly informed that a priest is available please contact the hospital's Spiritual Care Department.

Saint Katharine Drexel Prayer:

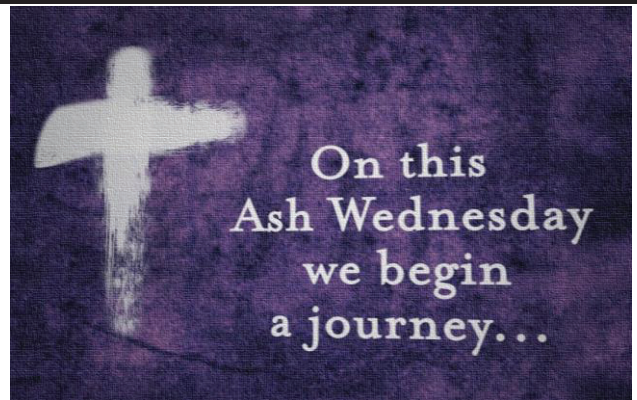
