

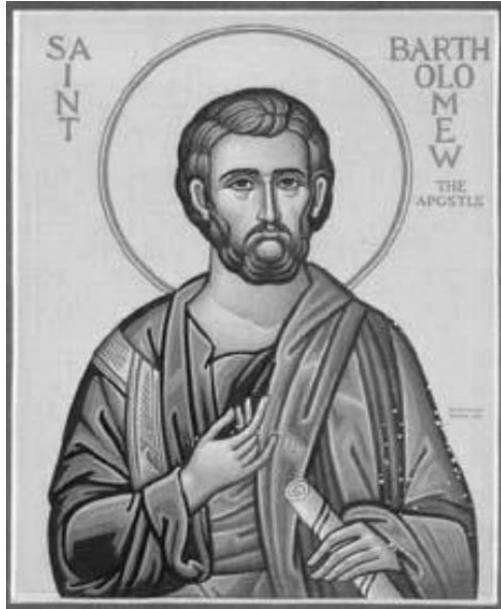

Gospel: JOHN 20:19-23

Jesus appears to His disciples and gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit.

FAMILY CONNECTION

Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the Church. The Gospel for Pentecost reminds us that the Church begins with the command to forgive. Within the family, the domestic Church, we learn how to forgive and we learn to accept forgiveness. It is the gift of the Holy Spirit that enables us to do both. Today is a fitting time to share a family celebration of reconciliation.

As you gather together as a family, sit quietly for a few minutes, inviting all to reflect upon their need to forgive and to receive forgiveness. If there is a situation or issue within the family that needs attention, spend some time reflecting upon the concern and how your family might address it. Read together today's Gospel, John 20:19-23. Talk together about how Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us in the work of forgiveness and to bring us peace. Pray together today's psalm, or the Prayer to the Holy Spirit, asking that the Holy Spirit help your family. Share with one another the sign of peace.

Prayer to the Holy Spirit



Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful.
And kindle in them the fire of your love.
Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created.
And you will renew the face of the earth.

Lord,
by the light of the Holy Spirit
you have taught the hearts of your faithful.
In the same Spirit help us to relish what is right
and always rejoice in your consolation.
We ask this through Christ our Lord.

You filled out the parish registration form. (Check with the parish office of you are registered).

The use of envelopes provides a record of Mass attendance which is of most importance for our spiritual health and a nourishment of our common Christian identity as the family of God. This way we also get to know who is who in our community, in terms of being beneficiaries and sharers of God's grace and blessings. ***Accordingly, the use of envelopes is not primarily about money, but spiritual growth, healing and nourishment within the context of our local spiritual family of faith.***

Using offertory envelopes not only allows the church to give you a yearly **receipt for income tax** but it also lets us know that you are a **regular parishioner**. This helps when you want to have a **Baptism, Communion, Confirmation or Marriage** in the parish or if you want a **letter of reference**.

Registering is easy! You can visit the Parish Office and request a registration form, or go to our website **stbartholomewssc.archtoronto.org**.

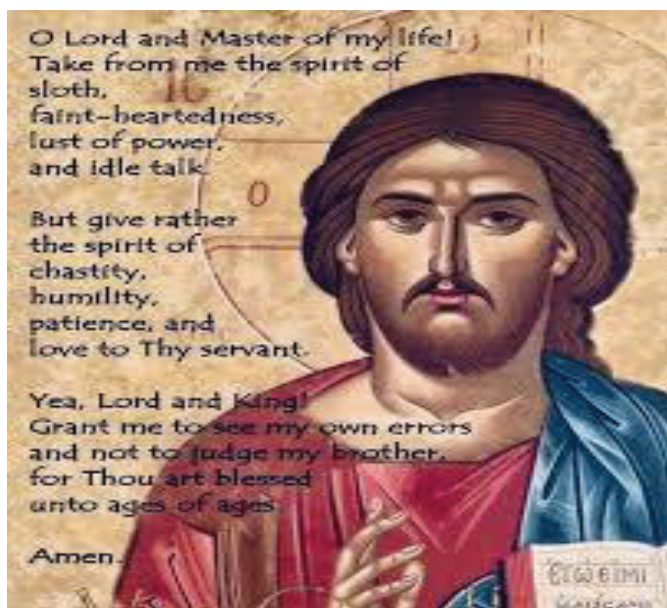
