

FAMILY CONNECTION

When someone in our family is going through a hard time, we can't just sit by and watch. We try to do everything we can to let him or her know that he or she is not alone. Sometimes we even try to find a special gift for him or her—something that will help that person to understand how important he or she is to us. Talk about times in your family when this has happened.

Like a good father, God saw that His children needed help. He decided to offer His beloved children a special gift to reveal His love. What did God give us? Not a thing, but a person—the Father's beloved Son, Jesus. Jesus, in turn, taught us to approach God as we would approach a loving father. He gave us the words of a prayer that we call the Our Father, or the Lord's Prayer.

Read aloud Luke 11:1-13. Talk about how Jesus teaches us to be persistent in prayer. Think of times when family members were persistent about something until they were able to achieve a goal or receive what they sought. Talk about what it means to be persistent in prayer. Help your children understand that prayer is not like sitting on Santa Claus's lap, asking for what we want until we get it. Emphasize that prayer is a way of striving to recognize how God is reaching out to us in love and responding by presenting Him with our needs.

Conclude this time together by joining hands and praying the Lord's Prayer.

Prayer to Saints Joachim and Anne


Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PARENTS OF GRADES 2, 3, 7 & 8

It is the responsibility of the parents to be active and alert to the announcements and information about the Sacramental preparation. Check our website, grab a bulletin and attend the weekend Masses to know what is happening in the parish. Pay attention to avoid disappointment.

If you are not a registered parishioner yet and you want your child to attend the sacramental preparation at St. Bartholomew Parish kindly fill out the parish registration form.

EXPLANATION OF PARISHIONER STATUS
The question of parishioner status is important.

ACTIVE & REGISTERED PARISHIONERS of St.

Bartholomew rightfully look to their Parish for any number of services. Among these services are:

- 1. Use of our facilities for liturgical service such as Baptism, Weddings and Funerals
- 2. Certification as sponsors of Sacramental celebrations

ACTIVE PARISHIONERS & REGISTERED:

To be considered active, parishioners must be registered in the Parish for a sufficient period of time, attend Mass faithfully, and support the Parish using the envelope system.

The use of envelopes provides a record of Mass attendance which is the most important consideration in these criteria.

The use of envelopes is not primarily about money; the envelopes provide a record of Mass attendance. When the Office Staff is asked to certify active parishioner status, they first look to the frequency of envelope use, not to the total amount given. With a record of regular Mass attendance, you will not have difficulty being certified as an active parishioner.

UNREGISTERED PARISHIONER STATUS:

Those who do not meet the expectations of active parishioners are classified "inactive/unregistered." Inactivity for 1 year would automatically change status to registered to unregistered.

Registering is easy. Go to the office and fill out or print out one from our website and bring it to the office.

<u>PARENTS:</u> If you have children living at home who are 18 years old or older, they need to register in the parish on their own.


