Gospel: **JOHN 6:51-58**

Jesus says, "I AM THE LIVING BREAD."

FAMILY CONNECTION:

Our faith teaches us that when we gather to celebrate Mass, Jesus is present to us. The bread and wine truly become the Body and Blood of Christ. This is what we mean by the word transubstantiation: Jesus makes Himself present to all who receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

If there are children in your family who have already celebrated their First Holy Communion, invite them to share their memories of this special day. If there are family photos taken on this occasion, bring them out and share them together. Adults in the family may also share memories or photos that they have of their First Communion. Then read together today's Gospel, John 6:51-58. Reflect together on what Jesus means when he calls himself the "living bread." Recall that every time we receive the Eucharist, Jesus keeps the promise He made in today's Gospel—those who eat His flesh and drink His blood will remain forever connected to Him. Perhaps family members can share what it means for them to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Together thank God for this gift of Holy Communion. Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's Psalm.



NEW TO THE PARISH OR HAVEN'T REGISTERED AS A PARISHIONER YET?

PLEASE DO NOT TAKE FOR GRANTED THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING A REGISTERED PARISHIONER. ATTENDING THE MASS HERE DOESN'T MEAN THAT YOU ARE. Did you fill up the registration form? Do you receive envelopes? If not, it could be quite frustrating to us, to you, and to your family when someone wants to make wedding plans, have a baby Baptized, or if you are asked to act as a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation requiring a note of Catholicity from us. If we have no record of your membership, we cannot do this.

<u>PARENTS:</u> If you have children living at home who are 18 years old or older, they need to register in the parish on their own.

Belonging to our parish community is more than filling out a registration form.

Why Should I Give?

- 1. Giving is one of the purest forms of worshipping God.
- 2. Giving demonstrates a dedicated heart.
- 3. Giving is an important part of God's nature and should be an important part of the nature of every believer.

"But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. — No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth." (Matthew 6:20-21; 24 NASU)

Using offertory envelopes/PAG (Pre-authorized giving) not only allows the church to give you a yearly **receipt for income tax** but it also lets us know that you are a **regular active parishioner**. This helps when you want to have a **Baptism**, **Communion**, **Confirmation or Marriage** in the parish or if you want a **letter of reference**. Father cannot say that you are a regular parishioner when he sees over 1000 people per weekend.


