
MARRIAGE: Contact the parish priest one year in advance. Please do not book the time and place of the wedding and reception before your appointment with the priest.

BAPTISM: Parents must be **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and regularly attend the Sacraments.

FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

These pr ograms normally run from September-May. Information Session takes place a week after the school opens in September (schedules are subject to changes). We only give one information session in a year. Dates are provided to the parish schools in the newsletter and also posted on our website, bulletin, bulletin boards and pastor's announcements as early as June. PARENTS must be **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and actively attend the Sacraments.

A man with many possessions asks Jesus what he must do to gain eternal life.

FAMILY CONNECTION

Today's Gospel might make us uncomfortable about our possessions. This discomfort offers us an opportunity to consider our possessions and our family's commitment to the poor. Material possessions are a necessity in our culture. Our use of these possessions and our attitude about their importance is our choice, however. It is a choice we can make with the awareness that our faith in Jesus commits us to show our care for the poor.

As you gather as a family, consider together these questions: Would it be possible to inventory our possessions? Are there things in our house that we no longer need or use? What might we do with these things? Read together today's Gospel, Mark 10:17-30. Talk about the warning about material possessions that Jesus gives in this Gospel. How does this make you feel? Choose an action that helps your family show its commitment to the poor. Conclude by praying together the Peace Prayer of Saint Francis.

- 4. One candle will be provided for every family. If you wish to have more a donation of \$10 will be appreciated.
- 5. Please submit <u>name of deceased, date of death, your relationship</u> on or before <u>October 25, 2024 (Friday)</u>. Email is preferred but you can also call the office. Just leave a message. For email on the subject line: <u>Memorial Mass</u>.
- 6. We also have the form available in the office. We will also need the name and phone number of the people who will be joining the Memorial Mass.

GUIDE TO FUNERAL ARRANGEMENT

- 1. Go to the funeral home of your choice. Don't call the church and make the arrangements yourself.
- 2. Discuss to the funeral director all that you wish for your loved ones funeral (date, time, organist etc.).
- 3. The funeral director will then call the parish to make the necessary arrangements
- 4. Once everything has been confirmed you will then be asked to see the pastor for the readings.
- 5. Call the parish office to set an appointment. Normally families would come to the parish after the arrangement in the funeral home.

Please note:

- 1. The funeral arrangement can only be done by immediate family.
- 2. The prayer service is done by either the deacon or priest on the day of the viewing which is the day before the funeral.
- 3. If you wanted another priest to do the funeral service the family must inform the parish office ahead of time. The bereaved family will take care of the stipend of the visiting priest on top of the donation to the parish.
- 5. Eulogy must be done at the funeral home (during visitation). This will prevent the delay of going to the cemetery. You will be charged by the cemetery if you are late.
- 6. If you wish for live streaming discuss with the funeral director. The parish doesn't provide that service.


