

Parents must be **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and regularly attend the Sacraments.

#### FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

These programs normally run from September-May. Information Session takes place a week after the school opens in September (schedules are subject to changes). We only give one information session in a year. Dates are provided to the parish schools in the newsletter and also posted on our website, bulletin, bulletin boards and pastor's announcements as early as June. PARENTS must be **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and actively attend the Sacraments.



#### **FIRST READING:** NEHEMIAH 8:2-4A,5-6,8-10

Ezra reads from the book of the Law and interprets it for all to understand.

#### **SECOND READING:** <u>1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-30</u> (OR SHORTER FORM, <u>1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-</u> 14,27)

Paul explains that all were Baptized into the one body of Christ.

#### **GOSPEL**: LUKE 1:1-4; 4:14-21

In the synagogue at Nazareth, Jesus reads aloud from the scroll of the prophet Isaiah and announces that this Scripture is now fulfilled.

#### **FAMILY CONNECTION:**

Jesus was the one sent by God to bring salvation to the world. Jesus announced that mission using the framework we hear in today's Gospel from the prophet Isaiah: glad tidings will be brought to the poor, liberty to captives, recovery of sight for the blind, and freedom for the oppressed. Jesus inaugurates the Kingdom of God in his person—through his life, death, and Resurrection. We are charged with the task of continuing the mission that Jesus began. Jesus set the framework for all of us when He announced His ministry in today's Gospel. Jesus also gave us the helper we would need to enable us to participate in His mission. The Holy Spirit has been given to us so that we, the Church, might serve the Kingdom of God.

Gather with your family and suggest that they try to picture the vision that Jesus describes using the words of the prophet Isaiah as you read today's Gospel, Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21. Think about your neighborhood, your community. What are the situations and who are the people who most need to see this vision fulfilled? What steps would be necessary to make the vision a reality for them? Make a family commitment to pray for the Kingdom of God and to take a particular action that will address a need




# Congratulations!


