

## **FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PREPARATION**

These programs normally run from September-May. Information Session takes place a week after the school opens in September (schedules are subject to changes). We only give one information session in a year. Dates are provided to the parish schools in the newsletter and also posted on our website, bulletin, bulletin boards and pastor's announcements as early as June. PARENTS must be **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and actively attend the Sacraments.

## THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD



## FIRST READING: MALACHI 3:1-4

The Lord you seek will come to the temple.

## SECOND READING: HEBREWS 2:14-18

Jesus became like us in order to save us.

## **GOSPEL<u>:</u> LUKE 2:22–40 (SHORTER FORM: LUKE 2:22–32)**

Simeon recognizes the infant Jesus as the promised Messiah.

## FAMILY CONNECTION:

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Discuss with the family the persons of Simeon and Anna as they meet Jesus. (Luke 2: 25–40)

Because Simeon and Anna lived lives of prayer and fasting in the Temple, they were filled with the Spirit of God. That is why they were able to identify Jesus as the Savior even though Jesus was only a baby. To these two holy people, He was recognizable as the Redeemer who had been promised. Simeon described Jesus as "a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

We too are called to recognize Jesus as Lord. Together as a family discuss ways to recognize Jesus as Lord by praying and attending Mass, fasting, and serving others. As a family, decide on one specific sacrifice you can make in order to alleviate the suffering or need of someone you know.









It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic school board in Ontario, as part of your application for employment there must be a PRIEST REFERENCE FORM. If you

(or if your adult child) is planning to apply to teach in a Catholic school, it is **highly recommended** you contact the pastor **before GRADUATING**. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early in the process and you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.

Read the form and find out what is required of you in order for the pastor to fill out the form favourably. Based on the questions of the reference form it is advisable that you start volunteering your time and talent to the parish.

## WHAT IS THE PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN?

The Archdiocese of Toronto has established a Pre-Authorized Giving Plan to assist you in your support of the work of St. Bartholomew Parish through your regular parish offerings.

The work of our parish is made possible through the giving hearts of our parishioners.

It's a very simple procedure. When you participate in Pre-Authorized Giving, your offering will be withdrawn from your bank account on or about the 20th day of the month. This amount will then be deposited to the Parish's account.

#### **ADVANTAGES FOR THE DONOR:**

• Convenience: Your offering is received automatically every month.

• Eco-minded Solution: The waste of printing and the use of boxes of envelopes are eliminated.

#### ADVANTAGES FOR ST. BARTHOLOMEW PARISH:

- Regular, dependable flow of contributions to the parish.
- Reduction of paperwork

#### HOW DO I ENROLL?

Decide on the amount of your monthly contribution to the Parish to be withdrawn from your bank account each month.

• Fill out, sign the Authorization Form, and attach a cheque from your account marked "VOID".

• Bring or mail both the signed Form and a voided cheque to the Parish Office.

#### CALCULATING THE MONTHLY PREAUTHORIZED GIVING

To help determine the amount of one's monthly deduction, the following calculation is presented as an example and guide. (Note that Special Diocesan collections have not been included in the calculation.)

### **Offertory:**

Average of \$15/week X 52 weeks = \$780 To calculate the monthly pre-authorized giving: Divide \$780 by 12 = \$65 per month

#### NOTE:

This is a sample amount you can give more as you wish.

#### **CONFIDENTIALITY & SECURITY**

The confidentiality and security of your personal information is extremely important to us. Our parish and the Archdiocese have taken appropriate measures to protect the security of your personal information. To assist, please make certain your enrollment form and void cheque are placed in a properly sealed envelope and placed in either the collection basket or mailed to the Parish Office.

100% of the donations collected for special collections are mailed to the diocese a month after the collection. Kindly ensure your donation is received within this time period.
