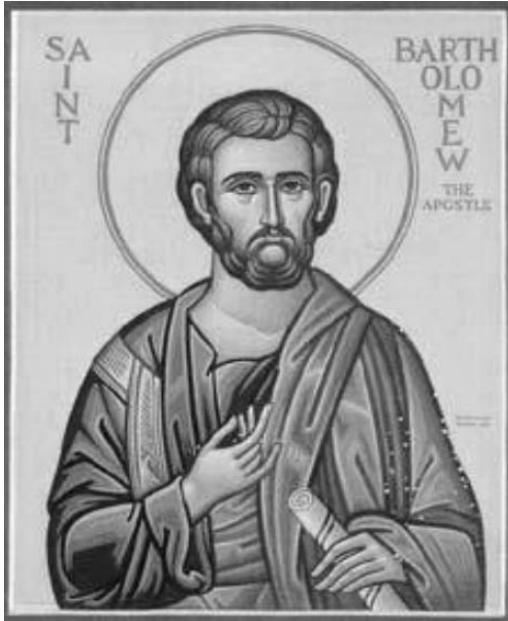

**FIRST READING: GENESIS 14:18-20**

Melchizedek, king of Salem, blessed Abram.

SECOND READING: 1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-26

As often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until He comes.

GOSPEL: LUKE 9:11B-17

They all ate and were satisfied.

FAMILY CONNECTION:

In our age of fast food and eating on the go, families often find that they are not eating meals together at a dinner table. As a family, look back over the past week and recall how many meals were eaten together and how many meals were eaten alone or on the run.

In the Bible, meals are seen as much more than a means to satisfy a physical need. The Hebrew people viewed eating a meal as a way of expressing and strengthening their relationship to one another under God's covenant. It is no coincidence that meals are often the setting of Jesus' teaching and miracles in the Gospels. In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear the story of Jesus feeding the crowd of 5,000 people.

Read this Sunday's Gospel, Luke 9:11b-17. Talk about the kinds of hungers that people have in addition to physical hunger. Describe the hungers that a family nourishes (love, compassion, forgiveness, laughter, and so on). Together give thanks for the food that Jesus gives us that we celebrate on this Sunday's feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus. Make a commitment to share in this Eucharistic meal together as a family.



Heavenly Father, we thank you for offering your Only Begotten Son as a sacrificial Lamb, who takes away the sins of the world.
We glorify your Name and give you Honour and Adoration, for the precious gift of the Real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.
Help us to become what we consume and radiate the graces we receive to all humanity. May we all live a Eucharistic life daily.
We ask you to keep us in communion with our Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus Christ our Lord,
Amen

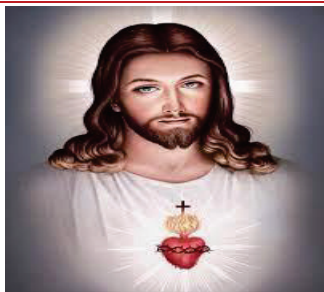

REGISTERED ACTIVE PARISHIONER MEANS:

You filled out the parish registration form. (Check with the parish office of you are registered).

Comes to Mass every Sundays and on days of obligation.

Uses offertory envelope, Pre-Authorized giving (PAG) or donating online.

The use of envelopes provides a record of Mass attendance which is of most importance for our spiritual health and a nourishment of our common Christian identity as the family of God. This way we also get to know who is who in our community, in terms of being beneficiaries and sharers of God's grace and blessings. **Accordingly, the use of envelopes is not primarily about money, but spiritual growth, healing and nourishment within the context of our local spiritual family of faith.**

Using offertory envelopes not only allows the church to give you a yearly **receipt for income tax** but it also lets us know that you are a **regular parishioner**. This helps when you want to have a **Baptism, Communion, Confirmation or Marriage** in the parish or if you want a **letter of reference**.

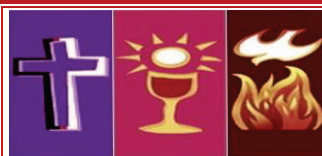
Additionally, the parish will not participate in the garage sale due to a lack of manpower. We will **NOT** be collecting any donations in kind for the garage sale this year.
