

#### **PARISH REGISTRATION**

#### **MARRIAGE**

Parents must be **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and regularly attend the Sacraments.

#### FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

These programs normally run from September-May. Information Session takes place a week after the school opens in September (schedules are subject to changes). We only give one information session in a year. Dates are provided to the parish schools in the newsletter and also posted on our website, bulletin, bulletin boards and pastor's announcements as early as June. Paul exhorts Timothy to stay faithful to God in all things.


#### **GOSPEL:** LUKE 16:19-31


