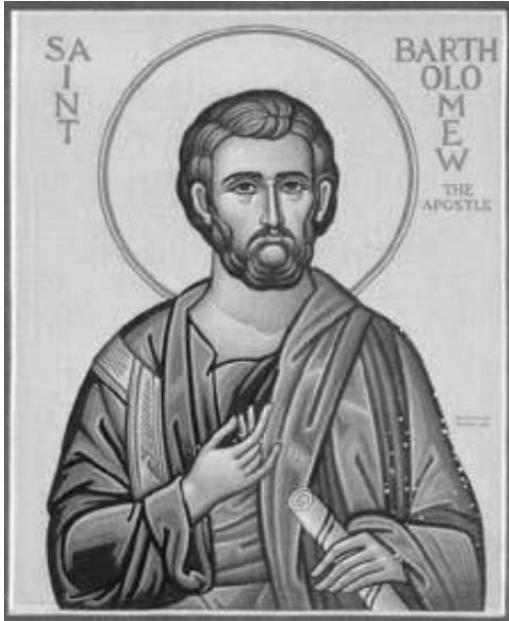

FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

These programs normally run from September-May. Information Session takes place a week after the school opens in September (schedules are subject to changes). We only give one information session in a year. Dates are provided to the parish schools in the newsletter and also posted on our website, bulletin, bulletin boards and pastor's announcements as early as June. **PARENTS must be REGISTERED PARISHIONERS** and actively attend the Sacraments.

ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



FIRST READING: EXODUS 19:2-6A

God tells Moses that the Israelites will be His special people.

SECOND READING: ROMANS 5:6-11

Though many, we are one body when we partake of the Body and Blood of Christ.

GOSPEL: MATTHEW 9:36-10:8

Jesus sends the twelve apostles to proclaim the kingdom of heaven.

FAMILY CONNECTION:

Every person in the Church is sent by Christ to do the work that He did. This task can seem daunting. Yet when we have learned to work together with others to achieve a common goal, we have learned something of what it means to do the work of Christ. The family is one such place in which we work with others, sharing a common task and a common goal.

As family members gather, invite each person to reflect upon their contributions to family life. Invite each one to share one or two things that they do to help keep your family life flowing smoothly. Take time to thank one another for the contributions each person makes to your family life.

Invite a family member to read aloud today's Gospel, Matthew 9:36-10:8. In this Gospel, Jesus sends the disciples to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. Point out that the disciples are called to work together just as family members must work together. Pray together that your family will always work together as a family to help one another. Pray that your family can be a model for other families. Pray together the Lord's Prayer.

Despite our best efforts, minor oversights may occur – nobody is perfect. We ask for your understanding and invite everyone to stay focused on what truly matters: our faith, our community, and our shared mission.

Information Registration:

SEPTEMBER 12, 2026, SATURDAY

- First Holy Communion: 10:00 AM
- Confirmation: 1:00 PM

Attendance Policy: Please note that we host only one **Information Session per year**. If you miss the scheduled session, please contact another parish regarding enrollment in their sacramental preparation program, as registration at our parish will not reopen until the next sacramental year.

Active Parish Registration: Parents, please ensure that your family is officially registered and active in our parish. An active member is regular in attendance and identifiable by using parish donation envelopes or being enrolled in pre-authorized giving. Please check with the parish office ahead of time if you need to verify your registration status.

Document & Donation Policy: To ensure no paperwork is misplaced, please hold onto all required documents and program donations. They will only be accepted in person during the scheduled **Information Sessions on September 12**. Please do not email forms to parish staff or drop them off at the parish office in advance. The completion and submission of these forms are the responsibility of the parents/legal guardians..
